STRENGTHEN THE FAMILY FARM

Generations of skill, hard work, sacrifice, and stewardship built Indiana's family farms. The U.S. government should support this work and make it easier, not harder, for farming and agribusiness operations to continue as the bedrock of our rural communities.

TIM SMITH WILL FIGHT TO:

- Permanently repeal the death tax
- ► Enhance credit availability for new farmers
- Support the safety net systems that provide a secure and stable food supply for all Americans
- Keep conservation voluntary and separate from crop insurance to maintain the freedom farmers require—crop insurance should be incentive-based

GROW NORTHEAST INDIANA'S RURAL ECONOMY

We all want to live in a place that enables our kids and grandkids to return home and pursue their dreams.

TIM SMITH WILL FIGHT TO:

- ▶ Support an all-of-the-above energy policy that expands American energy production, especially with common-sense solutions like investments in biofuels
- Invest in rural infrastructure, including roads, broadband internet, etc.
- Promote value-added agriculture—including biofuels, dairy, and meat processing—to create high skilled, high paying rural jobs

GUT REGULATION AND RED TAPE

Indiana ag producers are subject to a mountain of burdensome regulations, inspections, and reporting requirements, diverting valuable time and resources away from feeding the world.

TIM SMITH WILL FIGHT TO:

- ▶ Ensure unelected bureaucrats have less power than Congress
- Cut unnecessary, burdensome regulations (multiple permits shouldn't be required to clear a fence row)
- ▶ Advocate for agribusiness in disputes with regulators
- Prioritize ag interests when considering laws regarding water, public lands, and predator control policy
- ► End out of control Waters of the US (WOTUS) power grabs

OPEN GLOBAL MARKETS TO INDIANA AG PRODUCTS

Indiana ag producers are among the best, most highly productive, innovative, and quality-focused ag producers worldwide. With free and fair access to overseas markets, Indiana farmers and livestock producers can compete with producers anywhere, but they have to be given the chance.

TIM SMITH WILL FIGHT TO:

- ▶ Promote trade deals that don't place farmers' interests below those of our foreign competitors
- ▶ Eliminate non-tariff barriers to agricultural trade. Evidence-based science, not protectionism, should be the basis for agricultural trade regulation

PROTECT LIVESTOCK AGRICULTURE

The Humane Society of the United States, PETA, radical environmentalists, fake meat purveyors, and Democrats in Congress are threatening livestock agriculture.

TIM SMITH WILL FIGHT TO:

- Stop the Green New Deal and other radical environmental regulations
- Oppose unnecessary and unconstitutional regulations of animal husbandry (e.g. Proposition 12 in California)
- Require truth labeling of agriculture products (define meat, milk, etc.)
- ▶ Punish criminal activity against livestock producers
- ▶ Protect property rights—farmers should keep complete control of their land, livestock, and their way of life without government intervention

FOOD SECURITY IS NATIONAL SECURITY

Tim Smith believes the Chinese Communist Party has access to too much American data, land, and technological infrastructure. In Congress, Tim will fight to protect our data and security by banning TikTok and limiting the CCP's ability to buy up agricultural land and land near our national security sites.

TIM SMITH WILL FIGHT TO:

- Maintain the security of sensitive data collected by ag production systems owned in part by the CCP
- Maintain domestic control of meat production and processing to assure that farmers maintain complete control of their livestock without government intervention
